This week we hightlight St. Josephine Margaret Bakhita/Fortunata who was born around 1869 in Olgossa in the Darfur region of Sudan. She was traded as a slave for 12 years before being freed. She became a sister of the religious order of Canossian Daughters of Charity. During World War II, the people of the village of Schio regarded her as their protector. Although many bombs fell on the village, not one citizen died. Pope John Paul II canonized her on October 1, 2000. Her feast day is celebrated on February 8. 
<u>some important resources regarding Heart Month.</u> In May we will hold our Jump Rope for Heart fundraiser.
