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
School Updates:

As part of our School Improvement and Equity plan, we are focusing on the learning skills and work habits of Responsibility, Organization, Independent Work, Collaboration, Initiative, and Self-regulation. These skills and habits enable students to perform to the best of their abilities. Each week, we will focus on a different learning skill and work habit with whole

school announcements and activities in the classroom to make to ensure that each student knows what the criteria are for each of the skills and can self-assess to determine what they may need to work on to set goals for improvement. Last week we focused on responsibility. This week we will focus on organization. Ask your child(ren) about what they are learning in regards to being organized.
