Halloween: When selecting a costume, please ensure that it is not violent in nature (i.e. blood, guts, or gore). Additionally, please ensure your child will be able to put it on and take it off themselves. Students should not be wearing a mask at school. The costume should not contain offensive slogans or words. Students wearing inappropriate costumes will need to change into an appropriate costume or their uniform. As we have a number of students who have anaphylactic allergies to a number of foods, we ask that no



food items are sent to school to be shared. Each student is able to bring their own snacks for class celebrations, if permitted by the classroom teacher.

The students will participate in the Monster Bash and will have an opportunity to dance and show off their moves and costumes in the gym. The Catholic School Council will be selling popcorn for **\$2.00 a bag**. Students can bring in a toonie for popcorn. Students who ordered candy apples will also receive them on this day for consumption at home.

**Chocolate Campaign:** Thank you for your participation in the chocolate fundraiser. Our campaign ended on **October 20**.
